## **BOS'N PIPE NOTICE NOVEMBER 2011**

### **NOTICE TO MEMBERS**

The KCYC Board has approved the following temporary Bylaw Amendment recommendation to the Membership. The purpose of the amendment is to open up the eligibility for the 2012 Rear commodore position to a qualified KCYC member with less than two years of membership.

This proposed amendment is recommended by both the nominating committee and the KCYC Board of Directors. It is published in this Bos'n Pipe in accordance with the KCYC bylaws, Article VIII, which states the Bylaws may be only amended by a two-thirds vote of the voting members present at any general meeting held at least ten days after this proposed amendment has been mailed to each member.

**PROPOSED BYLAW AMENDMENT &  
PROVISION:**

Amend Article V, Section 1, by temporarily striking "for not less than two years"

**Current wording:**

Flag Officers are required to be boaters and to have maintained membership in good standing for not less than two years prior to his/her election to office.

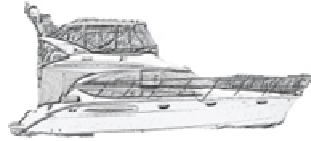
**Proposed temporary wording:**

Flag Officers are required to be boaters and to have maintained membership in good standing prior to his/her election to office.

**Provision:**

This amendment will expire on September 30, 2012 and Article V, Section 1, will revert back to its original wording.
