Bar opens at 6:00pm.

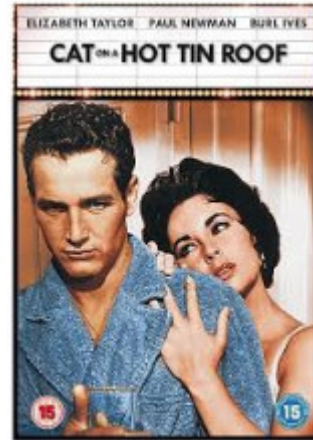
Play from 6:30pm - 8:30pm. Bar will be open until 9pm.

Cruise Lopez, Aug. 31st - Sept. 3rd

The 300 Dock has been reserved, spaces 301-313. They are 50' slips & we will fit as many as possible. First come, first served! Boaters need to call Lopez Islander Resort directly, tell them you are with KCYC & book your slip. 2 night minimum reservation. Reservations MUST BE MADE BY 7/31/18 or the extra slips will be given to outside boaters. Contact information: Lopez Islander Resort in Fishermans Bay on Lopez Island 360-468-2233, Kathy

- *If your boat will fit in a 30' slip, your fee is \$55/night.*
- *If your boat will fit in a 40' slip, your fee is \$66/night.*
- *If your boat will fit it a 50' slip, your fee is \$79/night.*
- *Cancellation Policy - no \$ refund, credit issued to be used within 1 year.*

If you are not coming by boat, there are rooms available in the Hotel at the Resort. Rooms vary from \$159/night to \$219/night plus taxes. Rooms include a small fridge, microwave & coffee maker. If you would like to leave your car in Anacortes, you may park in the Lopez Islander

Resort complimentary parking at the Anacortes Ferry, walk on the ferry & call for pickup by the complimentary shuttle which will take you to & from the ferry & hotel. Contact information: Lopez Islander Resort in Fishermans Bay on Lopez Island 360-468-2233, Kathy
